



Beer Buddy Bitter, 5.2%

This a real British-style beer designed for the cooler autumn evenings, made from 100% U.K grown raw materials.

The pale malt is derived from the classic Scottish spring barley, Golden Promise that is also the base of some of the finest scotch whiskies produced in that part of the British Isles. The addition of dark crystal malt and golden naked oats helps to give the beer its delightful sunset orange hue and a fantastic dry biscuity & slightly nutty character that complements the initial hit of sweet malt. If you look hard enough you can even find hints of Speyside's finest single malts in there somewhere!

The hop character is all English: the high alpha variety "Pilgrim" contributes the majority of the assertive bitterness, through its addition as the main Kettle hop, but is also responsible for the slightly minty hop character through its (perhaps unconventional) use as dry-hop after primary fermentation. Late kettle additions of East Kent Goldings and Fuggles provide the earthy, slightly grassy undertones to the beer that assist in drying out the beer to a long clean finish.
